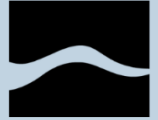


SERMON NOTES

BIG IDEA: In Deuteronomy 6:4-9 Moses provides three exhortations to keep us from the dangers of idolatry and lead us into the kind of life that God blesses.

How have you seen the here and now consequences of idolatry manifest in your own life?

What do you need to remember about God so that you might turn and trust in him instead of idols of your own making?

What role does the church body play in addressing idols of the heart?

What practical steps can you take in your heart, home and community to cultivate a love for God that satisfies and encapsulates all of your life.
