Read Psalm 31:1-5 and discuss what David believes about God and how it shaped his willingness to surrender himself entirely to God.
How does Jesus' cry from the cross fulfill David's words in Psalm 31:5?
APPLY THE TRUTH Who or what do you tend to call upon when you're hurting instead of your heavenly Father?
Why do you believe God is ultimately trustworthy?
Why is surrender sometimes difficult even though God is worthy of your trust?
What is one thing you need to surrender and entrust into God's hands fully?
