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#### Scripture Reading

Read John 13:12–17 aloud together.

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#### Observation Questions

1. How do the disciples respond to this action?
2. What command does Jesus give regarding this service?
3. What do you think it would have been like for Jesus to wash Judas feet?
4. How does this action illustrate humility and leadership?

#### Interpretation Questions

1. How is washing feet a significant example of missional service?
2. How does Jesus redefine leadership through service?
3. What does “do as I have done to you” imply for believers today?
4. How can everyday acts of service demonstrate God's glory?
5. Why is intentionality (“the why”) crucial in service?

## Application Questions

1. What opportunities for service exist in your home, workplace, or community this week?
  2. How can you serve someone who would not normally expect it?
  3. In what ways can you align your daily routines with God's mission?
  4. Who in your immediate circle needs encouragement, help, or prayer?
  5. How can you model humble service to inspire others to follow Christ?
