**WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE SEDER?**

The Seder dinner is the ceremonial meal that Jesus shared with His disciples the night before He went to the cross. This meal is tied to the Jewish Passover celebrations which commemorate the Exodus from Egypt and foreshadow the life and sacrifice of Jesus. It was at the traditional Seder dinner that Jesus picked up the symbolic elements of the bread and cup and gave us what we remember and celebrate with Communion.
