There will be a memorial service for Debbie Carter at CEC on Monday, August 18th at 11:00am with a reception to follow. Please wear a football jersey.

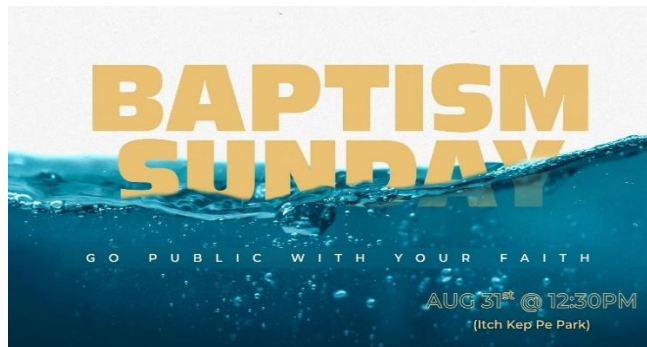
