Read Philippians 4:8-9 out loud as a group.

1. Paul frequently speaks about the mind of the believer throughout the New Testament. Read and discuss the passages listed below. What do they teach us about how the mind of a believer should think and operate?
 - Romans 12:1-2
 - 1 Corinthians 2:16
 - Philippians 2:1-11
 - Philippians 4:6-7
 - Romans 8:5-6
 - 2 Timothy 1:7
 - 2 Corinthians 10:3-6
2. In verse 8, Paul lists six virtues that the believer must 'take inventory of' continually and habitually. Which of these virtues do you think is most neglected in our church culture today, and why? Which of these virtues do you most need to grow in dwelling on?
3. In verse 9, why do you think Paul connects right thinking with right practice?
4. From the things you have learned and received from Paul's instruction to the Philippians through this letter as well as what you have heard and seen in Paul's own example, what is one thing you want to integrate into the practice of your everyday life?
5. How does spiritual warfare play a role in the battle of the mind? What have we been provided to help us in this area?
6. Take time to follow up on the people you each named who you identified that God has placed in your everyday life who needs to hear and see the gospel. How's it going? Could you be so bold to invite them to church for one of our Easter services?
