Resurrection Sunday Service Mark 16:1-6

1. "Now when the Sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices, that they might come and anoint Him." (Mark 16:1) What strikes you most about the example set by these women?
2. Compare and contrast the Resurrection accounts in the four Gospels (Matthew 28, Mark 16, Luke 24 and John 20). What do you find most interesting about these differing accounts?
3. In light of looking at the different Resurrection accounts, what questions are you left with that you will be asking Jesus in heaven?
4. When Jesus rose from the dead, He defeated both the penalty and power of sin in our lives. How do you live in light of that truth in your everyday life?
