Acts 21:1-26

1. From the text studied, identify and discuss the attributes seen in the life and character of Paul that made him perfect for the work to which God had called him to?

2. What lessons can we learn from both Philip the evangelist and Agabus the prophet?

3. Consider the following passages (Galatians 2:15-16, 19, 21; 3:2-3,10-14, 19-25; Romans 3:21-26; 8:1-4; 9:30-31). How is Paul unyielding about his obligation to spread the gospel to the Gentiles, and about their not having to keep the law?

4. Considering 1 Corinthians 9:19-23, how is Paul's undergoing the rites purification (Acts 21:26) a picture of allowing for adaptation of nonessentials for the sake of mission, without compromising the gospel or this identity in Christ?

5. In light of what we've studied from Acts 21:1-26, what is one lesson that you can apply to your life in the coming weeks? Be specific!
