Acts 26:24-32

1. Based on Paul's defence in Acts 26, what were some reasons for someone like Festus in his position to think that Paul was not in his right mind?
2. In Acts 26:25, Paul answers Festus saying: "I am not mad, most noble Festus, but speak the words of truth and reason." Discuss how the gospel is both true and reasonable. Why is that important to us?
3. What can we learn about 'simple gospel presentation' from Paul's conversation with King Agrippa in verses 25-29? What are some practical ways that we could apply these lessons when sharing the gospel with others?
4. Why do you think Agrippa came so close, but didn't put his faith in Jesus Christ?
5. Who are you actively sharing the gospel with? Share briefly with your Home Group and pray together for these people.
