Matthew: Hail to the King
Matthew 21:23-46

1. In response to the religious leader's question, Jesus asked them: *"The baptism of John - where was it from? From heaven or from men?"* (Matthew 21:25) Why do you think Jesus chose to ask them this question? What was point was He trying to make?

2. What was Jesus illustrating in the parable of the two sons in Matthew 21:28-32?

3. Does your mouth and what you profess match your lives? Do you practice what you preach? Think about this at an individual level but also at a church level.

4. Jesus confronted the rejection of the religious leaders in the parable of the wicked vinedressers, yet they were unwilling to change and repent. In what area of your life do you need to humble yourself before God and change? What are some practical steps you can make to allow God to work in your heart?
