

Home Group Discussion Questions

Read Philippians 4:1-5 out loud as a group.

1. How is Philippians 2 connected to the idea of reconciliation between believers? Keep in mind how the Lord has brought us the opportunity of reconciliation.
2. What does it practically mean to “be of the same mind in the Lord”?
3. How does the broken and unreconciled relationship between two people (like Euodia and Syntyche in the church in Philippi) impact the church itself and the witness the church is for Jesus?
4. In verse 4, Paul exhorts the believers to rejoice in the Lord always. What allows you to rejoice always? From what perspective must we be looking from?
5. How does remembering that “the Lord is at hand” shape how we respond to conflicts within the church?
6. Read Acts 16:11-15 and consider the impact of Paul and the women at the riverside on Lydia’s life. As a group, briefly follow up with each of the people you named who you identified that God has placed in your everyday life who needs to hear and see the gospel. What’s the next step or opportunity you can take this week?
