5 Day Devotional

Day 1: First Fruits: The Foundation of Faith

Devotional

When we think about giving to God, it's natural to consider what we might have left over after all our expenses. But God's economy works differently. He asks for our first and best not our leftovers. This principle of first fruits giving demonstrates our trust in God's provision and sets the tone for how we manage all our resources. When we prioritize giving to God first, we're making a powerful declaration of faith, saying, 'Lord, I trust you with everything.' This act of faith positions us to experience God's faithfulness in remarkable ways. Just as a farmer must first plant seeds before expecting a harvest, our giving plants seeds of faith that God promises to multiply.

Bible Verse

'Honor the Lord with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase; So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.' - Proverbs 3:9-10

Reflection Question

What would it look like in your life to truly put God first in your finances, rather than giving from what's left over?

Quote

When you give to God, it's the initial thing, first fruit that you give to God, you budget him, you say, the first of what I have, I give to God because it represents a blessing of what all that God and a dedication to the rest of what I have to God.

Prayer

Lord, give me the courage to trust You with my first fruits. Help me to break free from fear and step into the blessing of putting You first in my finances. Amen.

Day 2: Breaking Free from Fear

Devotional

Fear often holds us back from experiencing God's best, especially in our giving. We calculate, worry, and try to maintain control, but this approach actually limits what God can do through us. True generosity requires us to push past our fears and trust in God's promises. Bible Verse

Prayer

Father, help me overcome my fears about giving. Give me faith to trust in Your promises and courage to give generously. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Day 3: Vision-Driven Giving

Devotional

God works through vision. When we can see where we're going, it becomes easier to take steps of faith to get there. This applies powerfully to our giving. Having a clear vision for what God can do through our generosity helps us give with purpose and excitement rather than obligation. Writing down our giving goals and the impact we hope to make helps transform our giving from a routine activity into a purposeful investment in God's kingdom. It allows us to partner with God in specific ways and watch Him work through our faithfulness.

Bible Verse

'Write the vision And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it.' - Habakkuk 2:2

Reflection Question

What specific vision has God given you for your giving? How might writing it down help you stay focused and committed?

Quote

Write the vision down. Write your vision down. Write it down what you want God to do for you.

Prayer

Lord, give me clear vision for my giving. Show me the impact You want to make through my generosity. Help me to be faithful in pursuing this vision. Amen.

Day 4: Planning for Prosperity

Devotional

Success in any area of life rarely happens by accident. This is especially true in our giving journey. God honors those who take time to plan their giving and approach it with intentionality. When we combine faith with careful planning, we position ourselves for God's prosperity. Bible Verse

Prayer

Day 5: Living in God's Abundance

Devotional
