may we encounter Jesus in that space.”***

1. Trust Jesus with your ARGUMENT.

Matthew 11:2-3 - “Now when John heard in prison about the deeds of the Christ, he sent word by his disciples and said to him, “Are you the One who is to come, or shall we look for another?”

2. Trust Jesus with your ALIGNMENT.

Matthew 11:4-5- “And Jesus answered them, “Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind receive their sight and the lame walk, lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised up, and the poor have good news preached to them.”

3. Trust Jesus with your ASSIGNMENT.

Matthew 11:6 - “And blessed is the one who is not offended by Me.”
Luke 9:23 - “And He was saying to them all, “If anyone wishes to follow Me [as My disciple], he must deny himself [set aside selfish interests], and take up his cross daily [expressing a willingness to endure whatever may come] and follow Me [believing in Me, conforming to My example in living and, if need be, suffering or perhaps dying because of faith in Me]. (AMP)
