



## "I'm All In" - Pastor Ray Clark HOPE GROUP STUDY - Week of April 12, 2026

### 1 Let's Talk & Pray

What is something in your life that you've gone "all in" on—and what made you commit fully?? After everyone shares, pray together for your study.

### 2 Let's Review the Main Idea

In Acts 2, we see a powerful picture of the early church—a group of believers who were completely committed to God. Their faith wasn't casual; it was all in. They devoted themselves to four key things: God's Word, community, breaking bread, and prayer. Being "all in" starts with God's Word. We are called to pursue truth, sit in God's presence, and let His Word shape our lives. Being all in also means committing to the right people, and it also includes remembering Jesus through breaking bread—living with gratitude and awareness of His sacrifice. Finally, a life that is all in is marked by prayer. Prayer is not about perfection, but connection. It's powerful, effective, and essential for a vibrant spiritual life.

### 4 Let's Think

- Why do you think the early church saw such powerful growth and impact?
- What do you think life was like as a follower of Jesus at that time?

### 5 Let's Share

- Which of the four areas (Word, church/community, breaking bread, prayer) is strongest in your life? Which is weakest?
- How does being around the wrong people affect your walk with God? Who are some people in your life that encourage your walk with God?
- What has your experience with prayer been like—easy, difficult, inconsistent? What are some barriers that keep you from prayer? What can you do to change that?

### 6 Let's Grow

- What is one practical step you can take this week to be more committed to God's Word?
- How can you intentionally invest in godly community this week?
- When is the next time you will intentionally remember and reflect on what Jesus has done for you?
- Set a specific time this week to pray—what will you bring to God?

### 7 Let's Pray

- Pray together for the Lord to align our lives, renew our minds, and position us for His favor; pray for prayer requests, too.
