1 Let's Talk & Pray

Have everyone share: "What is one way you see your faith growing?"
Open with prayer after sharing answers.

2 Let's Review the Main Idea

There's a generation crying out because they are hungry... what does that cry sound like? Anxiety, fear, confusion, stress, entitlement... This generation is so hungry trying to fill up on the things of this world, just to take away the hunger pangs.

Nothing will satisfy this generation, until we go to God and His presence. To experience Him, His presence, we need to elevate our worship. David used his position to bring the presence of God to a hungry generation - and we can bring His presence to this generation, too.

Psalms 24; 2 Samuel 6:11-23

4 Let's Think

- Why do you think David wanted to bring the ark of the covenant back to God's people? How did David experience God already in his life?
- How did David use his position for God's glory?

5 Let's Share

- What is one way you feel that this generation is crying out for something more in life? Have you been there before? How did God answer your cry?
- How have you used your position to bring God's presence into your sphere of influence?
- Who has used their position to bring you closer to God? How did that experience elevate your worship to God?

6 Let's Grow

- What mission do you feel God leading you to do? Who will benefit from your obedience?
- After David had the ark set in its place, he blessed the people. Why does God's presence bring blessing into our lives? How has His presence blessed your life?
- Where do you need to take the presence of God? Who needs you to speak the blessing of His name over them?
- How can you take steps this week to elevate someone's future with God?
