## "It's Not Over"

### HOPE GROUP STUDY - Week of May 26, 2024

Let's review this week's message, "You Can Finish, Too"

#### 1 Let's Talk & Pray

Ask everyone to share the following:

Who has been the best mentor or coach in your life? After everyone has shared, pray for your time together.

#### 2 Let's Review the Main Idea

We only get one life. Let's not get to the place and say, "I wish I would have served... I wish I would have been generous or taken that risk... I wish I hadn't quit..."

Let's ask ourselves the question, "What am I living for? What am I willing to fight for?"

Let's look at Paul's words to Timothy to encourage him to keep going in spite of hardship. Let's review this week's points from this message:

- FIGHT the right fight
- FINISH the right race
- FAITHFULLY live for your "finally."

#### 3 Let's Read the Word

2 Timothy 4:7-8; 1 Timothy 1:18; 1 Timothy 6:12;  
1 Corinthians 9:24; 2 Corinthians 11:23-28

#### 4 Let's Think

- When you read Paul's words, "I have fought the good fight..." - what falls under the category of the good fight for Paul? Did he have any regrets?
- What do you think is Paul's reason for writing Timothy these words?
- What do you think Timothy was fighting at that time?

#### 5 Let's Share

- What struggles did Paul face that could have caused him to give up? What struggles have tempted you before to give up?
- What is the "right fight" for you right now? What does winning the fight look like to you? What did it look like to Paul?
- How has your faith been opposed lately? Why is it important to know why opposition happens in our lives?

#### 6 Let's Grow

- What ways can we strengthen our faith to stay in the fight? How committed are you to do them?
- How can we ensure that we will have the same attitude of Paul at the end of our lives?
- What can you learn about relationships/mentorship for your faith from Paul & Timothy? Do you have relationships that nourish your faith? Who in your life can be your "Paul" or who can you be "Paul" to?
- What kind of certainty does Paul have to receive his crown of righteousness, his "finally?" Do you have the same certainty?

#### 8 Let's Pray

- Pray over requests together as a group.
