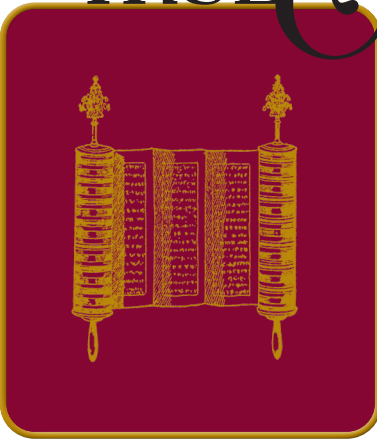

READ

- Hebrews 3:1-6 and Deuteronomy 18:15-18, considering what lessons the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- Explain who Moses is and why he is significant to Christianity. What did he accomplish? What did his life represent? What do we learn from his story?
- How does the author of Hebrews compare and contrast Jesus and Moses? What does it mean that Moses is “servant” and Jesus is “son”? Are there any other Scriptures that come to mind that present Jesus as the True and Better Moses?
- Moses said in Deuteronomy 18:15 that God would raise up a prophet like him. What does it mean for Jesus to be a prophet like Moses? What is the significance of Peter attributing this verse to Jesus in Acts 3:22?

APPLY

- What impact does Jesus’ superiority over Moses have on our faith?
- How should we live in light of Jesus’ superiority and authority? What response is Hebrews seeking to elicit from us.
- What truths about Jesus here may be especially valuable in sharing the gospel with others?
- Speaking of Moses, the New Living Translation renders v.5, “His work was an illustration of the truths God would reveal later.” How does this influence the way Christians relate to the Old Testament?

PRAY

- Take time to praise God for who He is, confess sins, and/or make requests based on this passage.
