READ

EXAMINE

- How does the Great Commandment to love God and love people shape what it means to be a disciple?
- What does it mean to love God with all your heart, soul, and mind? How is this possible?
- How does our own discipleship to Jesus affect our mission to make disciples?

APPLY

- Why is your personal relationship with Jesus so foundational in fulfilling your role in the Great Commission?
- Do you see yourself as a convert or a disciple of Jesus?
- Have you grown in your love for God since becoming a disciple? What are some ways you have grown?
- What practices will help you prioritize growing in your love and discipleship to Jesus? How is your community relevant to these practices?

Spend time praising God, confessing sin, and bringing requests to Him in response to this passage.
