READ

Read Luke 10:25-37 and consider what lessons the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- How does Jesus' parable relate to both the Great Commandment (Matt. 22:34-40) and Great Commission (Matt. 28:18-20)?
- Based on Jesus' parable, how would you define who your neighbor is?
- Sharing the gospel is absolutely central to Christian mission. How does showing mercy like the Good Samaritan relate to our evangelism and mission as believers?
- Jews and Samaritans were known enemies. How does this story of compassion across enemy lines inform the way Christians make disciples of all nations?

APPLY

- What practical steps can you take to grow in the discipline of evangelism?
- Who are some "neighbors" that you can reach with the gospel? How can showing them mercy and compassion be part of this process?
- How can you ensure that you both see and act on "Good Samaritan" opportunities in your life?
