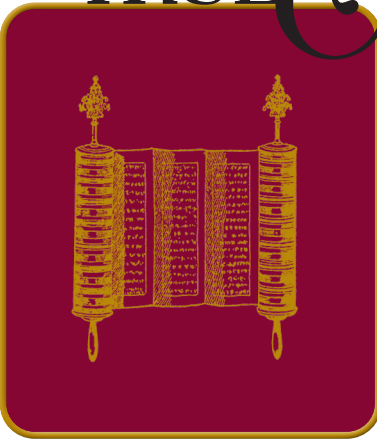

READ

- Read Hebrews 10:1-18 and consider what lessons the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- According to this passage, what is the problem with the Old Testament sacrificial system? How did the OT sacrificial system address the problem of sin, and why was this only a temporary solution?
- If “it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins” (v.4), how was God dealing with sin prior to Jesus’ death?
- The writer of Hebrews puts the words of Psalm 40:6-8 in Jesus’ mouth. Why? What does this reveal about Jesus’ identity and purpose?
- How does Jesus accomplish “a single sacrifice for all sins” (v.12)? What does it mean that “he sat down at the right hand of God” (v.12) and “he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified” (v.14)?

APPLY

- Summarize the gospel according to this passage. How can this sacrifice apply to a person? How would you share this message with a non-Christian?
- How does the truth of Christ’s atoning sacrifice affect your daily life as a Christian?
- If Jesus’ sacrifice for us leads to the forgiveness of sins, how does this shape our approach to sin as Christians?
- Sanctification refers to becoming holy (like Jesus). Why does verse 10 speak of Christians as those who have been sanctified, but verse 14 speaks of Christians as those who are being sanctified?

PRAY

- Take time to praise God for who He is, confess sins, and/or make requests based on this passage.
