READ

Read Matthew 28:16-20 and consider what lessons the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- How does the context of Jesus' death and resurrection shape our understanding of this passage?
- Why is the authority of Jesus so significant to the Great Commission?
- What does it mean to "make disciples" according to Jesus. How is making disciples more than evangelism?
- Why is it important that the disciples have Jesus' ongoing presence as they fulfill the Great Commission?

APPLY

- How do we see West Park's mission to Love God, Love People, and Impact the World in the Great Commission?
- When you consider West Park's mission to Love God, Love People, and Impact the World, which do you find the most difficult? Why is that, and how can we as a community help each other here?
- What are some ways we prioritize corporate worship? Is participating in regular corporate worship difficult for you?
- What are some ways we can be engaged in transformative gospel community? What is a practical next step you can take to be in community?
- God calls his followers to sacrificially serve others. What are some of the barriers to this kind of gospel service? What are some areas God may be calling you to serve others?

PRAY

- Take time to praise God for who He is, confess sins, and/or make requests based on this passage.
