



#### Senior Pastor Search Committee Update

We wanted to give a quick update on where we are as your Senior Pastor Search/Transition Committee. In June we finished our Church Information Form (CIF) and posted the position online. We established a process by which to evaluate candidates and have been receiving applications since mid-June. As appropriate, we have been conducting our first and second round of interviews. Please continue to be in prayer for the committee, the applicants, and our church. Please pray for the committee's discernment and that we clearly hear the will of God in this process. At the January 15, 2017 Congregational Meeting, the congregation will be asked to consider an action to renew Pastor Alberta's call for one year beyond his 70th birthday. This is consistent with the overall plan that was outlined when the Senior Pastor Search/Transition Committee was put into place a year ago. This in no way impacts the process or timeline for selection of the next Senior Pastor at Cornerstone and provides the flexibility that had been envisioned for an orderly transition as further events unfold.
