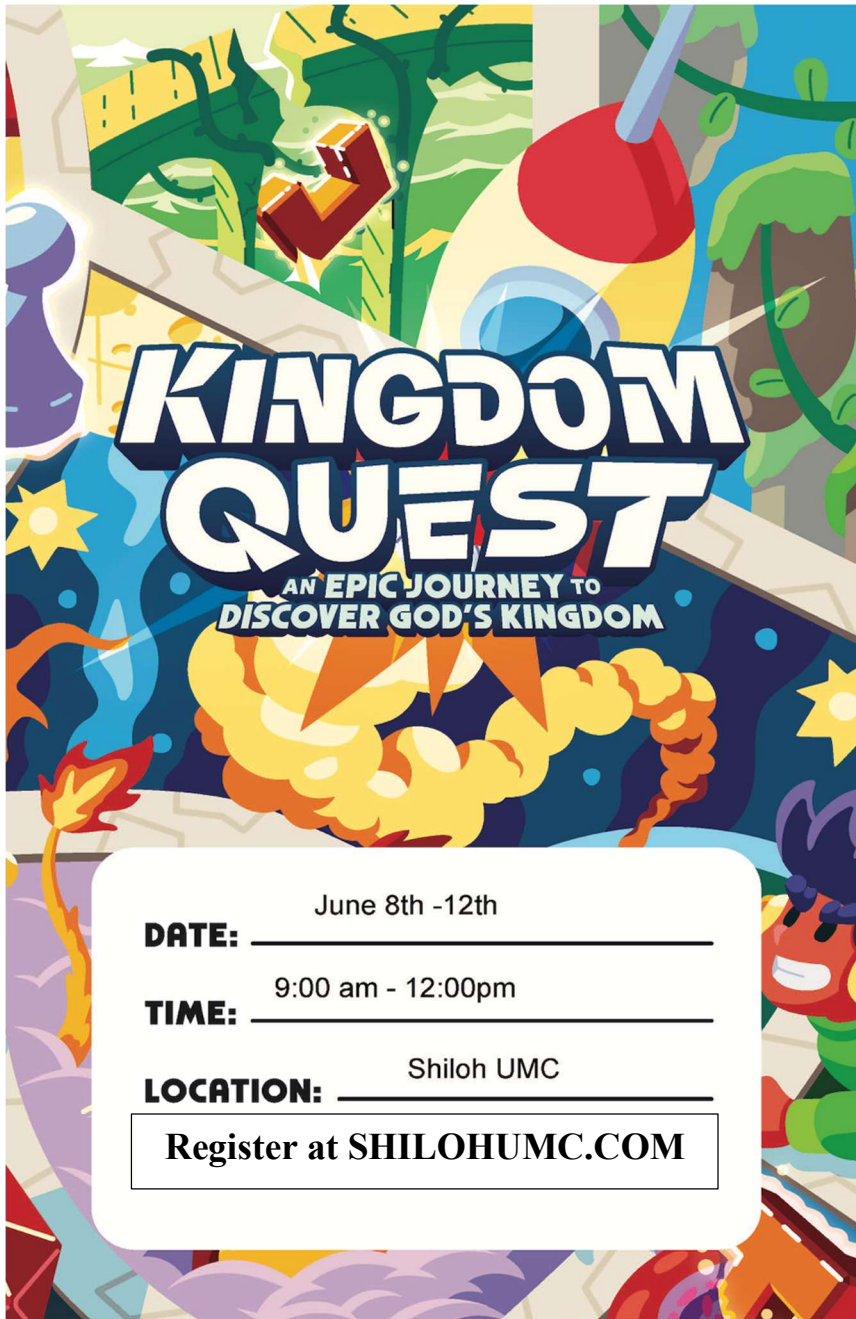

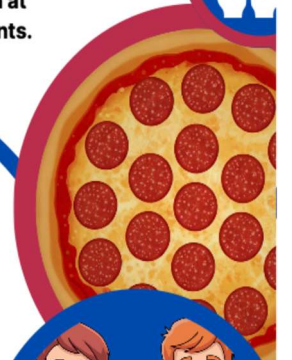

1 Corinthians 13:4-8

Week #1 – Words can build up and words can tear down – James 3:7-10

- Ephesians 4:29 – NRSV
 - Let no evil talk come out of your mouths, but only what is useful for building up, as there is need, so that your words may give grace to those who hear.
- Sapros (Greek) words – Words that are evil – they tear down.
- Karris (Greek) words – Words that are grace-filled – they build up

Week #2 – Family Words - Colossians 3:8-15

- Ways to speak Karris (Grace Filled words) into others' lives
 - Say, "I love you."
 - Listen – James 1:19
 - I am Sorry, I Forgive You – Colossians 3:13
 - Give Thanks – Colossians 3:15

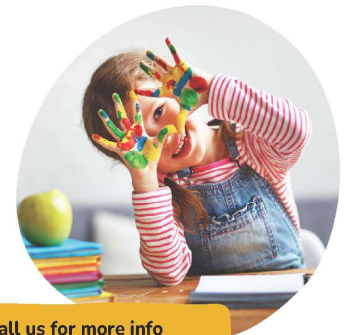
