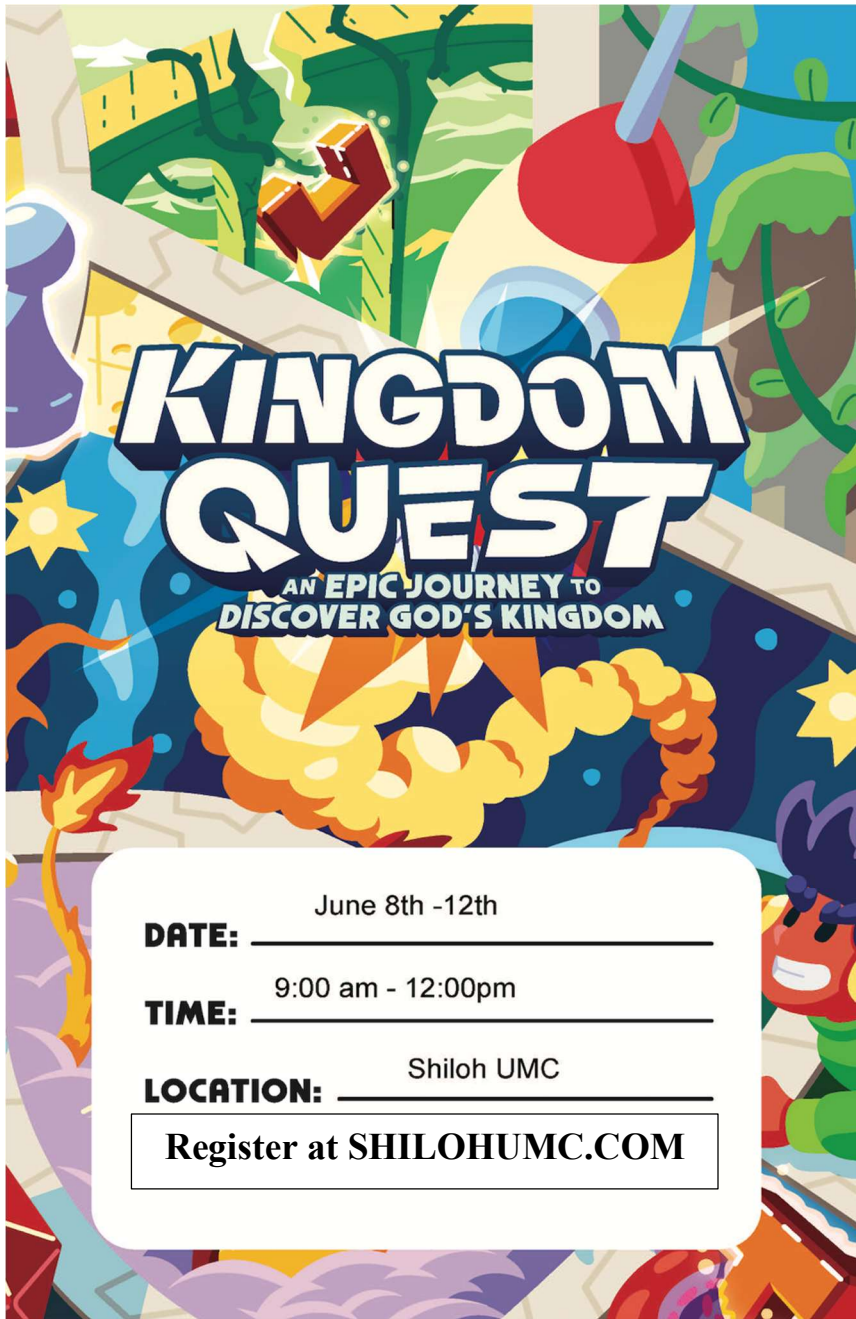

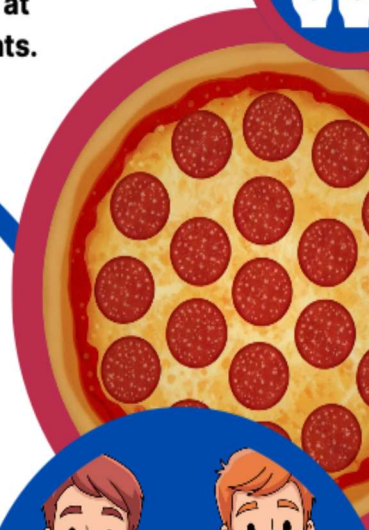

Ephesians 2:1-10

Gifts tell us that we are loved.

- Pick one.
- Are You Sure?

Everyone is a Gift

- Spiritual Gifts
 - At first, it's fun.
 - Then, if you don't use it, our interest fades.
- The value of our giftedness comes from the value placed upon us.
 - Our view of God determines how we see ourselves
 - If God is vindictive and angry, we never take risks.
 - If God is loving and grace-filled, we are free to take risks.
- The stronger we get in faith, the confidence we get in God.
- And confidence in God:
 - changes our relationship with God – Ephesians 2:4-9
 - changes our response to others – Ephesians 2:1-3
 - changes our relationship with ourselves – Ephesians 2:10
- The greatest gift we receive – Christ's death and resurrection.
- OUR job is to get people to open their gifts.

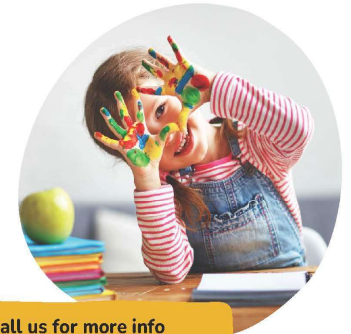
