Mark 14:53-64

- Week #1 – The Last Supper – Luke 22:14-20
 - Liberation from slavery.
 - Freedom from servitude.
 - Deliverance from bondage.
 - John 8:36
- Week #2 – The Garden of Gethsemane – Mark 4:32-42
 - Jesus was 100% human and 100% divine.
 - Not what I will, but what you will.
- Fear is not a sin.
 - Peter had fear – and came to the courtyard.
 - The Sanhedrin had fear – and sinned.
 - 71 members – the chief priests, the elders, and the teachers of the law AND the High Priest.
 - In the middle of the night...
- The Fear that made them sin:
 - They disagreed with Jesus.
 - They agreed with Jesus.
 - They lost... a lot.
 - ½ Shekel = 2 days' pay (\$135).
 - A perfect animal.
- How will you respond to fear?
