Let no evil talk come out of your mouths, but only what is useful for building up,^[a] as there is need, so that your words may give grace to those who hear.

 - o They can Build Up
 - o They can Tear Down
- Ephesians 4:29 – NRSVUE
 - o Let no evil talk come out of your mouths, but only what is useful for building up,^[a] as there is need, so that your words may give grace to those who hear.
- The Church at Ephesus
 - o Paul establishes a church – spent 2 years!
 - o After Paul left – they began arguing with each other.
 - o Paul's response – the book of Ephesians
- You CAN be angry and disagree, BUT...
 - o Do so with humility
 - o Do so with grace
- Evil = Sapro (Greek)
- Grace = Karris (Greek)
- What can we do?
 - o #1. Speak Better to others in our life.
 - o #2. STOP Tale Bearing
