**"24 Hours That Changed the World – Week #4"**

Jesus, Barnabas, and Pilate

March 15, 2026

Matthew 27:24-26

- Week #1 – The Last Supper – Luke 22:14-20
  - Liberation from slavery.
  - Freedom from servitude.
  - Deliverance from bondage.
  - John 8:36
- Week #2 – The Garden of Gethsemane – Mark 14:32-42
  - Jesus was 100% human and 100% divine.
  - Jesus prayer in the garden – take this cup from me.
  - Not what I will, but what you will.
- Week #3 – Condemned by the Righteous – Mark 14:53-64
- Peter had fear – and came to the courtyard.
- The Sanhedrin had fear – and sinned.
  - They disagreed with Jesus.
  - They agreed with Jesus.
  - They lost... a lot.
- *Pax Romana* – the Peace of Rome
  - Rome wanted their money and peace.
  - Pilate was the Roman governor – one who ruled with absolute authority.
- The Sanhedrin bring Jesus to Pilate
  - Accuse him of proclaiming he was "King of the Jews."
  - Pilate questions Jesus.
  - "You have said so" – Jesus' answers put Pilate in a tough place – Matthew 27:11-14
- Pilate tries to get out of it by releasing Barabbas
  - It doesn't work
  - His wife shows up – Matthew 27:19
- Pilate HAD THE ANSWER and didn't take it.
  - Will we act with courage or with cowardice?
