

 - The tomb should be the end... but it wasn't!
 - The evil of Friday is transformed into the miracle of Sunday.
 - It's a story that's as old as humanity itself
 - Cain vs, Abel – good vs. evil.
 - In Jesus' time, good didn't usually win.
 - The Cosmic Battle – Round #1
 - Jesus teaches, heals, feeds, commands (the storms), and is popular.

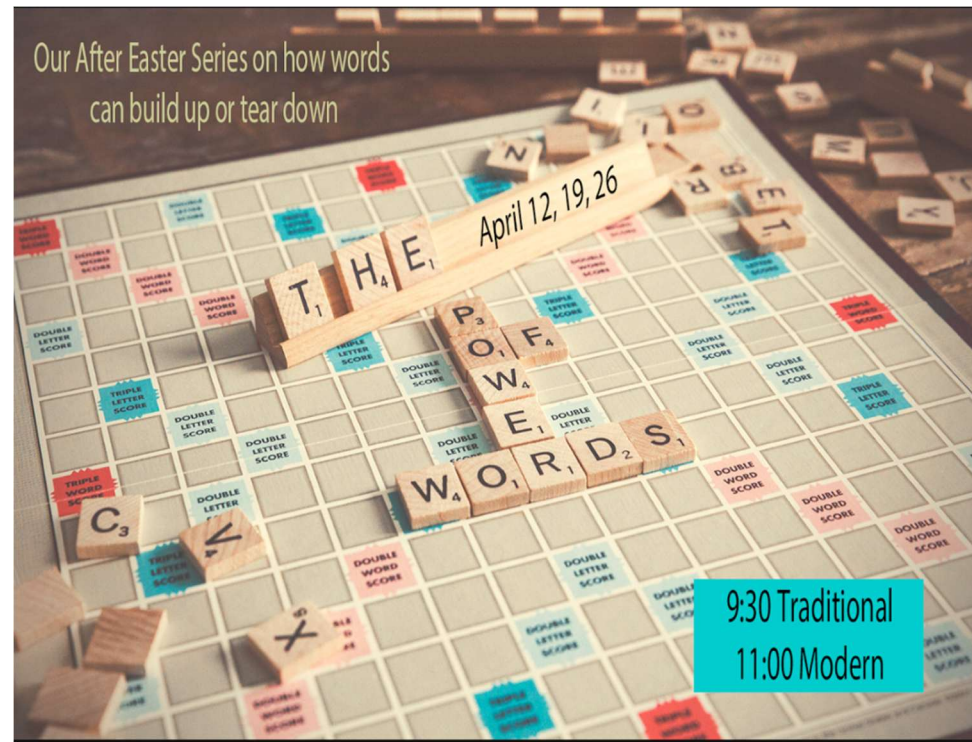
