#### I. Why are some people more patient than others?

**2.** By definition, it can't be that a person demonstrating patience isn't facing things that would "try his/her patience."

Patience: accepting pains or hardships calmly or without complaint / continuing despite difficulties, opposition, or discouragement (Merriam – Webster)

**1 Cor 13:4** Love is patient / suffers long (NKJV) The Greek word μακρός (long) and θυμός (thermos) passion, angry, heat. Used here it means "taking a long time to boil."

### II. Patient people have "great understanding."

**Pro 14:29** Whoever is patient has great understanding... **Pro 19:11** A person's wisdom yields patience...

1. They just have a purpose that's bigger than their problems / circumstances. ("Great Command, Great Commission, Golden rule")

**Rom 8:28** He (God) works all thing for the good of those who love Him and are called according to **His purpose**. (Rom 5:3-4; Jas 1:2-4)

**Heb 12:1-4** ...let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, <sup>2</sup> fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. <sup>3</sup> Consider him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.

## **2.** They grasp God's love and patients for them (Eph 3:17-19)

**Matt. 18:26-27** "At this the servant fell on his knees before him. 'Be patient with me,' he begged, 'and I will pay back everything.' <sup>27</sup> The servant's master took pity on him, canceled the debt and let him go.
