

## Day 4: Obedience and Divine Appointments

**Reading:** Acts 8:26–40

**Key Verse:** “Then Philip opened his mouth... and he told him the good news about Jesus.”  
—Acts 8:35 (ESV)

Philip didn’t get the full map. He got a direction: “Go south.” And he went.

That obedience led to a divine appointment with a man reading Scripture on the side of the road. A conversation. A conversion. A baptism. All because Philip was tuned into the Spirit’s voice and willing to obey.

God still works this way.

When we begin our day in prayer—when we say, “God, I’m not moving unless You go with me”—we posture ourselves for unexpected kingdom moments. The grocery store. The sidewalk. The inbox. These can become holy ground.
