### A Life Sacrificed

- Leviticus 17:11
- Leviticus 16 – The Day of Atonement – Summary
  - \_\_\_\_\_ entered Holy of Holies – 1 day a year
  - Blood and flesh of an innocent animal \_\_\_\_\_ offered up on the altar
  - To make Atonement – “\_\_\_\_\_”
  - Purpose – to \_\_\_\_\_ the broken relationship between humans and God by covering the sins of the people
- Leviticus 16:34 (NLT) — 34 This is a permanent law for you, to purify the people of Israel from their sins, making them right with the Lord once each year.”

### The Perfect Sacrifice - Hebrews 9 and 10

- The old system only a \_\_\_\_\_ of the good to come
  - The sacrifices under that system were never able to provide \_\_\_\_\_ cleansing
  - It is not possible for the blood of \_\_\_\_\_ to take away sins (it only Atoned – “covered”)
  - Christ came into the world – “You gave me a \_\_\_\_\_ to offer”
  - I have come to do your \_\_\_\_\_
  - He \_\_\_\_\_ the first covenant in order to put the second into effect
- Hebrews 10:10
  - Hebrews 10:14
  - Hebrews 9:11–12

### Passover and a New Covenant – Luke 22:7-20

- Go and prepare the \_\_\_\_\_ meal
- Jesus – \_\_\_\_\_ to eat this Passover meal with his disciples before his suffering begins
- Bread broken in pieces – my \_\_\_\_\_ given for you

- Cup of wine – the \_\_\_\_\_ between God and his people
- An agreement \_\_\_\_\_ with his blood – poured out as a sacrifice

### The Prophetic Word Come to Pass

- Isaiah 53:3-7 ...he never said a word. He was led like a lamb to the slaughter. And as a sheep is silent before the shearers, he did not open his mouth.
- 1 Peter 1:18–20 (NLT) ...It was the precious blood of Christ, the sinless, spotless Lamb of God.
- 1 Corinthians 5:7 (NLT) ... Christ, our Passover Lamb, has been sacrificed for us.
- Revelation 5:1–9
  - “Who is \_\_\_\_\_ to break the seals on this scroll and open it?”
  - \_\_\_\_\_ was found worthy
  - A Lamb that looked like it had been \_\_\_\_\_
  - The lamb took the scroll – \_\_\_\_\_ to open the scroll
  - The elders sang a new song with these words: “You are \_\_\_\_\_ to take the scroll and break its seals and open it.
  - For you were slaughtered, and your blood has \_\_\_\_\_ people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation.

### Abraham – Willing to do what God \_\_\_\_\_ do

- You? – Willing to do what God \_\_\_\_\_ do?
- Romans 12:1 (NLT) — ... Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.
- Galatians 2:20 (NLT) — 20 My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So, I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
