- Conformed – Destined to be conformed to the image of Jesus
- Romans 8:29
- Is there a conflict?
  - Telling you to be who you are
  - Telling you to conform to one who is beyond who you are
- Genesis 1:26
- Psalm 139:14–16
- Ecclesiastes 12:6–7
- Genesis 2:7 (KJV – living soul)
- Body – created from the elements that make up the earth
- Spirit – given by God (Eccl. 12:7)
- Soul – thinks, makes decisions, feels (Mind, Will, Emotions)

  - I cling to your laws, don't let me be put to shame
