- A completed purpose - John 17:1-5
- To glory – Philippians 2:9-11
 - God elevated him
 - Name above all names
 - Every knee bow, every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord
 - To the glory of God, the Father
- Our Glory to Glory
- Ecclesiastes 12:6-7
- Psalm 139:13-16
 - The Spirit of each person was given by God
 - We were fashioned and knit together, spirit, soul and body by God
 - We were given a purpose, a life plan, by God
- The plan includes transformation into the image of Jesus – glory to glory in the present
- 2 Corinthians 3:16-18
- The plan included transformation into the likeness of Christ in glorified bodies – glory to glory in the future
