The Huddle

- The Huddle – Defined
 - A closely gathered group, mass, or heap; bunch.
 - For instructions, signals, etc., from the team captain or quarterback, usually held before each offensive play.
- The Church's Huddle – our gatherings
- Purpose of the Huddle
 - Celebrate the last plays
 - Check on everyone to see if they are okay
 - Encourage through the mistakes made in order to press through and instill confidence
 - Get the instructions of the coach/quarterback
 - Stir each other on toward the victory

Biblical Directive for the Huddle – Hebrews 10:19-25

- V.25 – let us not neglect our meeting together
- Encourage one another especially now that the day of his return is drawing near
- V.24 – motivate one another to acts of love and good works
- V.19-23 – boldly enter the presence of God
- Cleansed with Christ's blood
- Washed with pure water
- Holding tightly to the hope of the promise of God

Do not neglect the place of God's presence

- Acts 3:20 Then times of refreshment will come from the presence of the Lord...
- Exodus 33:16 ...your presence among us sets your people and me apart from all other people on the earth.”
- Ephesians 2:22 ...this dwelling where God lives by his Spirit.

Do not neglect the instructions of the Lord

- Psalm 19:7–8 (NLT) — 7 The instructions of the Lord are perfect, reviving the soul. The decrees of the Lord are trustworthy, making wise the simple. 8 The commandments of the Lord are right, bringing joy to the heart. The commands of the Lord are clear, giving insight for living.

Moses, having been in the Lord's presence and having received his instruction...

- 2 Corinthians 3:7 ...For his face shone with the glory of God...
- 2 Corinthians 3:8 Shouldn't we expect far greater glory under the new way, now that the Holy Spirit is giving life?
- 2 Corinthians 3:18see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.
