

DELIVERANCE

"The weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses" (2 Corinthians 10:4)

*We keep ourselves unstained by sin and addictions. We do not participate in deeds of darkness but we stand and pray in His Light, demolishing every stronghold.

Prayer:

"Oh Mighty Warrior in heaven we come before you praying as we walk in the authority You have given us on this earth. We pray that we would be strong and courageous walking by your Spirit. We pray that the chains binding those in darkness be broken. We pray for deliverance in our own lives, in our families, our churches, our workplaces, and in the government. We are on the alert knowing Satan is roaming like a roaring lion, but know that we are wise to his plans. O God, we pray for increased anointing, increased knowledge, increased understanding of our authority in You. We pray for deliverance over those who are hurting, those who are prisoners of darkness. You desire freedom. You desire liberty. You desire that each person come to know you as Savior that they may fulfill the wonderful plan you have for them. Lord we come against arrogance, pride, distractions, undiscipline, selfishness, anger, strife, busyness, witchcraft, financial disarray, disease, sickness, mental torment, suicide, and discontentment. Oh Lord God, break every chain. We overcome by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimonies. We pray in the all-powerful Name of Jesus."
