### Last Supper

- John 13:1-7 Washing the Disciples Feet
  - Jesus' hour of departure from this world had come
  - The devil put into the heart of Judas to betray Jesus
  - Jesus began to wash the disciples' feet (another expression of humility)
- Matthew 26:26-30 the Lord's Supper
  - The bread the body of Jesus
  - The wine the blood of Jesus
  - A Covenant confirmed between God and his people
  - A sacrifice to forgive the sins of many

## The critical teachings of Jesus before his death

- John 14-16
  - Jesus, the only way to the Father
  - The Promise of the Holy Spirit one like himself who would live in them
  - I am leaving you with the gift of peace of mind and heart
  - I am going away but I will come back again
  - The ruler of the world has no power over me, but I will do what the Father requires of me
  - Abide in the vine and produce much fruit
  - The commandment love each other as Jesus loved them
  - No greater love than to lay down one's life for their friend
  - The Holy Spirit will guide you into all truth
  - You will have sorrow now, but your grief will suddenly turn to wonderful joy
  - No one can take that joy away from you
  - Here on earth you will have many trials, but take heart, I have overcome the world

- Father, bring me into the glory we shared before the world began
- I have revealed you to the ones you gave me
- My prayer is for those you have given me
