JESUS AND THE WORKPLACE

Psalm 19:12 and Psalm 139:23-24

Why is it so important to examine your own motives or be self aware of the things that trigger you? Do you fall into the trap of blaming others in the workplace?

WHAT NOW?

As a group do the Examen together. The Examen is a spiritual practice that involves a daily or weekly review by taking a few minutes to go back over the events of the day/week and ask God to show you evidence of His presence and ourselves in light of His presence.

Preparation: spend a few moments in silence, allowing yourself to become aware of God's loving presence.

Review the day:

- Look back on the events of the day, asking God to show you where He was present with you.
- Ask God to show you the places where you are growing and changing.
- Ask God to show you places where you fell short of Christlikeness. This is not about shame, simply name your failure honestly, confess it to God and receive His forgiveness (1 Jn. 1:9)
- Thank God for the day and for his presence in your life.

PRAY

Pray for each other asking God to help each of you become more aware of His presence in all of life and to grow in your ability to choose Christlikeness in areas where you find it most challenging.
