Let's Talk:

What are you thankful for today?

What makes you fearful of today?

Let's Study:

Read Luke 15:1-10.

Jesus sat with sinners and tax collectors. What groups of people does our society marginalize? Why do you think some don't see there to be a need to reach out to these groups?

Why do you think the shepherd wasn't content with just having 99 of his sheep safe? Was it really worth leaving the majority to go search for the one? Why?

Both parables emphasize the same truth. What observations can you make about the owners' actions?

Read Luke 15 verses 7 & 10 and Matthew 18:13-14.

These verses give us a glimpse of the priorities of heaven. What does this say to you about God's desire for the lost?

What are some barriers that keep believers from sharing their faith? Are there less or more barriers during this time of self distancing? Explain.

Let's Apply:

Where have you seen God at work recently?

How can you join in what He is doing?

Let's Pray:

Spend time praying for the fears mentioned by members of your group. Pray for faith and trust in God, the pursuer of the lost.
