Study questions for C4 Connect Groups and individual use.

LUKE 19: 1–10

How do you feel about paying taxes?

What type of people would you say are looked down on in our society?

CONTEXT - What does the Scripture say?

Read the passage in two different bible versions. What is your initial response to this story?

CONNECT - What does the Scripture mean?

How did the sermon inform you and impact your understanding of this passage?

v. 1-4 Why did people hate Zacchaeus so much?

Zacchaeus actively sought to see Jesus. Would you climb a tree or push your way through the crowd? Why do you think he pursued Jesus so earnestly?

Out of the thousands of people surrounding Jesus and standing along the road, why do you think Jesus stopped and talked with Zacchaeus?

When others encounter Jesus, and you don't, do you feel ripped off? Do you complain?

What does Zacchaeus' response tell us about his heart? Why is he so enthusiastically volunteering to be poor?

What does his response tell us about what faith and repentance are?

CONTEMPLATE - What does the Scripture mean to me?

How are you like Zacchaeus?

Is your salvation evident in your life? Was there a change in behavior when you believed?

Is your life marked by generosity? Do riches and wealth and being successful in business have a grip on you?

COMMUNITY - How will you live this out in your life?

What would a church full of Zacchaeus' look like?

Do you know a 'Zacchaeus'? Will you go and meet with him, have a conversation? Tell them about Jesus?
