

## Let's Talk:

Your community and thus multiple voices have influenced your identity, whose voice has had the greatest impact on who you are today? And why?

## Let's Study:

Read Exodus 33:7-11.

What was the purpose of the tent of meeting? Who else could go to the tent? What does this tell you about God? What does verse 11 show us about Moses' relationship to God?

Read 1 John 2:1.

Moses would make intercession for the Israelites. What does this verse say Jesus is doing? What other parallels can you think of between Moses and Christ?

Read John 15: 13-15.

Jesus is saying that those who trust and obey Him because of their relationship with Him, He calls 'friends'. Share what that means to you.

Read Hebrews 10:19.

What does it mean that we can enter the Holy place? How did Jesus' death on the cross bring about the accessibility of God?

## Let's Apply:

The tent of meeting was important and intentional for Moses and those he led. Do you have a 'tent of meeting'? What does it look like? Who is impacted by whether or not you have this?

Pastor Nathan said, 'the heart of being a friend is to know the heart of the one who befriends you'. Is there anything specific you want to know God's heart about? How could you get to know it this week?

Ponder together what would it do to our discipleship, our worship, and our evangelism if we could grasp the full implications of the fact that, like Moses, we are God's 'friends' through Jesus Christ?

## Let's Pray:

Being a friend of God, leads to interceding for others. Take time to pray for one another's needs and to celebrate God's work in one another's lives.
