LET'S TALK

What was your understanding of the Trinity in the environment in which you grew up? Was there a certain person of the Trinity who was emphasized more? Father, Son or Holy Spirit?

Is there a person of the Trinity that you have felt more connected to? Who do you pray to most often?

What's the hardest part of the Trinity for you to grasp?

Did today's sermon help your understanding of the Trinity in any way? How?

Read and discuss this definition of the Trinity:

"Within his own mysterious being God is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The designations are just ways in which God is God. Within the Godhead there are three "persons" who are neither three Gods nor three parts of God, but coequally and coeternally God."

GO TO THE WORD Read Ephesians 3:14-17 How are each member of the Trinity described in these verses?

Discuss JT's quote:

'You cannot know God, you cannot talk to Jesus, experience Jesus at all, without the Holy Spirit for he is God. You have never had a real experience with Jesus or the Father without the Holy Spirit. He is the only source, only door, he is the only access to Jesus, as Jesus is the only access to the Father! He is not an it, he is not a force, he is not ghost, he is God, he is a person in the godhead and he is your everything if you are a Christian.'



Read Romans 11:33

Do you agree with this statement? "We need mystery in our lives." Why or why not? Greek def. of mystery = open secret, one that has been revealed.

Read 2 Corinthians 13:14 What do these verses say to you about who God can be to you personally?

Read Revelation 22:1-4 and John 7:38-39 Reflect on the image of God in these verses.

WHAT NOW? How does understanding the Trinity affect your relationship with God? Why is it important that we know God in all His fullness?

PRAY Spend time praying to God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.
