### Let's Study

Read Matthew 25:31-34 and 41-46.

This passage describes how Jesus will come to end history and He will separate people of all nations according to how they demonstrated their love for Him by serving those in need. What impacts you most from this passage?

Read Luke 16:19-28.

In this parable, after the rich man dies, he goes to hell. What do you notice about what hell is like for him? How do you think this compares to what your non believing friends and family think about hell?

Read Matthew 13:42, 25:41 and Mark 9:48.

According to Jesus' teaching in these verses, describe what He says hell will be like. Who was hell prepared for? How long does the conscious punishment in hell last? How does the reality of hell make you feel?

Why do you think people deny or ignore the teaching of Scripture about hell?

### Let's Apply

Does it seem loving or unloving to you, to speak about hell?

The rich man begged for Lazarus to be sent to his father's house. Is there someone you want to warn?

Randy Alcorn wrote 'Consider the wonder of it: God determined that he would rather go to hell on our behalf than live in heaven without us. He so much wants us not to go to hell that he paid a horrible price on the cross so that we wouldn't have to.' 1 Corinthians 6:20 says, you were bought at a price. Have you accepted the redemption offered through Jesus Christ? If yes, thank Him. If not, share with your group what is holding you back.

### Let's Pray

Pray that we would grow in our understanding of the two eternal destinations and that it would motivate us to tell others, even though conversations may be difficult.
