#### Let's Talk

Take time to get to know one another more by playing this Ice Breaker: Set a 1 minute timer for group members to find something within an arms reach that is meaningful to you. Each person then has 1 minute to share about their object, including information like where they got it, and why they keep it.

At Sanctus Church, the purpose of Connect Groups is <u>connection</u> - doing life together in Biblical Community. What does 'doing life together' mean to you?

#### Let's Study

Ray Vander laan wrote, "the disciple's deepest desire was to follow their rabbi so closely that they would start to think and act like him." Discuss how being a disciple of Jesus would have been different when Jesus walked the earth to what it is like today.

Read Hebrews 10:19-25

What is the danger in <u>not</u> meeting with other believers? What are the benefits of meeting with other believers? What does this verse say we should be doing when we meet?

In the book Transformation Groups, Ed Stetzer and Eric Geiger wrote, "community is a place to love and be loved, to receive and extend grace, to watch others be transformed and to be transformed...groups are the primary place where this transformation happens." Have you seen or experienced this? If so, share an example.
