## Let's Study

- 1. Now that we're coming near the end of the Book of Revelation, chapters 15 18 have two major themes surfacing more than once. What are they?
- **2. Read Revelation 18:1.** What is Babylon the Great? How is it personified and why?
- **3. Read Genesis 11:1-4.** What is the significance of the Tower of Babel? How does Babel lay the foundation for Babylon?
- **4. Read Isaiah 1:21.** In these different sections of scripture, similar language is used to describe fallen/sinful cities or places: one in the Old Testament, and one in the New Testament. What do the scriptures reveal about which cities are in danger and will suffer the same consequence?

# Let's Apply

- 1. Pastor Jon lists 'markers' in Revelation 15-18 that help us determine where Babylon is and when we are living in it:
  - The true living God is removed from the centre of family, city and country
  - sex and sexuality are practiced without the permissions and boundaries of God
  - luxury and materialism are at the heart of a culture
  - injustice and slavery abound
  - violence

Where do you see examples of this in your own life, your family, your church, your community, your country and your world?



### Let's Apply

2. They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator—who is forever praised. Romans 1:25

In the sermon, Pastor Jon shared that "spiritual conflict is always happening in two areas: doctrine and experience." Spiritual deception was another marker of the end times.

What are God's people called to do in Revelation 13:10 to counter spiritual deception and false teaching?
