CONNECT GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: SUNDAY NOVEMBER 4/ 2018

LET'S TALK:

How did the sermon impact you? What has stood out most to you so far in this study of Daniel?

GO TO THE WORD: Read Daniel 3:19- 30. What are some things that you observe from this passage of scripture?

Read Ex. 20:4-5. Why do you think humans have a tendency to build idols?

Compare Luke 22:42 with Daniel 3:17-18. Share a time you prayed a similar 2-part prayer.

Read Daniel 3:19. Have you ever had to speak up for God's truth in the midst of negativity? What happened?

Read Isaiah 43:2. What is your favourite promise from the Old Testament? What scriptures do you rely on and recite?

Read Daniel 3:26-27 and discuss what it means when 'God is our shield.'

Pastor Jon said “we are called to *love and live* within the city, but also to *stand* when needed.” Discuss what that could look like.

Read Romans 13:7. What does it mean to you to be a “good citizen?” Why is this important to God?

Read Isaiah 7:14 and discuss the meaning of “Immanuel.”

Read the poem *Footprints in the Sand* and open up about a challenging time in your walk with Jesus.

Where might you suffer in our culture as a follower of Christ? How prepared do you feel?

Read Mark 12:30-31. Are you actively “loving your neighbours?”

WHAT NOW:

How could you as individuals or as a connect group take action to “love your neighbours?”

PRAY:

Pray that God would show us how to engage in mission and truly love our neighbours. Pray that we would be good citizens and discern when we need to take a stand for Jesus. Continue to proclaim the goodness of our God, and thank Him that He promises to be with us and never to forsake us. He really is “God with us!”
