CONNECT GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: SUNDAY NOVEMBER 18/ 2018

LET'S TALK:

What are you grateful for this week? What has been challenging this week?

GO TO THE WORD:

Read Daniel 4:2 and John 4:39-41. Have you ever shared your personal encounter/testimony publicly? Where might God be asking you to tell others about His impact on your life?

Read Daniel 4:20-23. What do you recall from the sermon regarding the symbolism of Trees? Google "axis mundi".

Read Daniel 4:24-27. What is Daniel's advice and what are the 3 sins mentioned?

Try to recall all 10 commandments as a group! (if you need help, read Exodus 20:1-17.) Which of the commandments do you find most challenging to uphold?

What modern day humanitarian crisis or social issue is most disturbing and unsettling to you?

Read Romans 1:21-23. The Hebrews believe “The greatest fool of all is the *disobedient* person who possess the greatest intelligence.” Discuss.

Read Daniel 4:34 and look up the definitions of: praise, honour and glorified in Hebrew/Aramaic.

Psalms 75:6-7 In light of this text, how should we respond to leaders and those placed above us? How do you balance ambition and humility in the workplace?

WHAT NOW:

Read Luke 7:34 and Mark 2:15-17 and discuss “Association does not mean you agree but you *love*.” Brainstorm opportunities for you to interact with and demonstrate love to people you might not normally want to associate with. What is one tangible action you can take this week to show love and mercy? Commit to taking action and hold one another accountable as a group.

PRAY:

Pray for your words to be seasoned with grace when talking with people who may be seen as “tax collectors.” Pray for opportunities to testify of God’s goodness. Pray for humility and God’s favour according to Isaiah 66:2b. Remember Pastor Jon said “Meekness is not weakness” pray for one another that we may all grow in meekness.
