### **LET'S TALK:**

How did the sermon impact you? What stood out most?

**GO TO THE WORD: Read Daniel 4:1-18. What are some things that you observe from this passage of scripture?**

Read Job 42:2 and Psalm 135:6 and discuss what "the Sovereignty of God" means to you.

Read Psalm 34:8, 1 John 1:5 and 1 John 4:8 and share what you know to be true about God's essence.

Pastor Jon said "Pride has always been the problem." Read Genesis 3:5 and Proverbs 16:18 and share your own struggles with pride.

Read Daniel 4:15-16 and look up the meaning of "lycanthropy". Why do you think this happened?

Read 1 Peter 5:6 and Philippians 2:3-11. Has God ever humbled you? What is the most humbling experience you've had?

Read Daniel 4:27 and discuss what we learn about Daniel's heart from this passage.

Read Matthew 5:38-39. Pastor Jon said: "Daniel tries to help the king, he loves the king, he does not gleefully celebrate when he hears the king is going to go down!" Do you need to repent from any times you've disrespected leaders, or failed to show love to your enemies?

Read Matthew 6:24 and explore why money and wealth are such common stumbling blocks.

### **WHAT NOW:**

Read Mark 10:23 and remember that Pastor Jon said "the key to understanding and speaking to wealthy, rich, powerful, wicked, arrogant people is to ask God himself to deal with them." How does this help you in your life as you face challenging people

### **PRAY:**

Pray for your enemies, and pray that God would empower you to love your enemies, and resist authority- when necessary- with kindness and respect. Pray that we as a group and a church will bear the fruit of humility, and pray against pride. Pray for rich, powerful people in our city and country; pray that God breaks in so they cannot deny Him.

**HOMEWORK:** Read Daniel 4:19-37.
