# The Cross and Passion of Our Lord Are the Hour of His Glory

- The King of Israel comes into His royal glory by the path of humble obedience "to the point of death, even death on a cross" He "goes as it has been determined" according to the Scriptures, willingly submitting to His Father's plan for the salvation of sinners. "Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name." (Phil. 2:9)
- His suffering and death open the way of repentance for the forgiveness of sins because He goes to the cross bearing the sins of the world. In His resurrection, God the Father vindicates His people and has compassion on His servants (Deut. 32:36)
- He kills to make alive; He wounds in order to heal. In remembrance of Him, we praise God, confessing "that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." (Phil. 2:11)

- 1. IF ONLY WE KNEW ON WHAT OUR PEACE WITH GOD DEPENDS
  - A. THE TRAGEDY OF NOT SEEING THE TRUTH ABOUT OURSELVES OR GOD
  - B. THE POWERFUL PEACE OF GOD FOR THOSE ENLIGHTENED BY THE SPIRIT
- 2. IF ONLY WE KNEW ON WHAT OUR PROTECTION FROM GOD DEPENDS
  - A. THE TRAGEDY OF TRUSTING IN THE WORK OF OUR OWN HANDS
  - B. SUPERNATURAL PROTECTION IN THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST
- 3. In His only begotten Son, God visits His people with salvation
  - A. IN THE KINGDOM OF GRACE, THROUGH SPOKEN AND VISIBLE WORDS
  - B. IN THE KINGDOM OF GLORY, OUR BLESSED HOPE. (TITUS 2:12-13)

### PRAYER OF THE CHURCH. PALM SUNDAY. 10 APRIL 2022.

Lord God and King, Your Son entered into Jerusalem as the true ruler, poised to lay down His life for His people. Grant that same mind to those in authority over us, that they would discharge their duty even to the least among us, and so receive Your commendation. Lord, in Your mercy, **hear our prayer.**
