# **APPOINTED READINGS 5 MARCH 2023**

Old Testament/Genesis 12:1–9. Epistle/Romans 4:1–17. Gospel/ John 3:1–17 The Word of the Gospel Opens the Eyes of Faith and Fixes Them on Christ Jesus

- The Lord called Abram (Abraham) to leave his home and go to a land that God would show him. He also promised to make of Abram "a great nation," to bless him and make his name great as a blessing to "all the families of the earth". "Abram went, as the LORD had told him", and in Canaan "he built an altar to the LORD and called upon the name of the LORD". (Gen. 12:8)
- Abraham "believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness". Here the grace of God is manifested, that He "justifies the ungodly", not by works of the Law, but through faith in His promises. He removes all of our sins and lawless deeds through Jesus Christ, the offspring of Abraham in whom all the Lord's promises are realized. This forgiveness of sins is the Word of the Gospel, the voice of the Holy Spirit, which "gives life to the dead". (Rom. 4:17)
- The Holy Spirit opens the eyes of faith to behold Christ Jesus, the Son of Man lifted up on the cross, "that whoever believes in him may have eternal life." (John 3:14–15)

#### **SERMON NOTES**

5 March 2023 In This Way God Loved the World John 3:16-17

For in this way God loved the world, so that he gave his one and only Son, in order that everyone who believes in him will not perish but will have eternal life.

For God did not send his Son into the world in order that He should condemn the world, but in order that the world should be saved through Him.

Because God sees that we are in need of rescue and cannot save ourselves, He gives the greatest Love this world has ever known that we might not be lost but enjoy life with Him forever.
