SECOND SUNDAY AFTER CHRISTMAS. 2 January 2022 1 Kings 3:4–15. Ephesians 1:3–14. Luke 2:40–52 The Lord Jesus Is Found in the Temple of His Church

- The Lord Jesus "grew and became strong"; He "increased in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and man." (Luke 40- 2:52).

 As His body grew and developed, His mind also increased in knowledge and understanding. For as our brother in the flesh, that we might *"have redemption through his blood"* (Eph. 1:7), He lived by faith in the Word of His Father. Thus, He was catechized by His parents, who took Him up *"to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover"* (Luke 2:41); when He was of age, He gave attention to the Holy Scriptures in His Father's house (Luke 2:46, 49). Christ Jesus is still found in His Church, in *"the word of truth, the gospel,"* by which we are adopted by His Father and sealed with His Spirit. (Eph. 1:5, 13).
- Thus do we gain *"an understanding mind"* to go about our vocations, discerning *"between good and evil"* (1 Kings 3:9). And so do we also go up to Jerusalem, to stand *"before the ark of the covenant of the Lord"* that is, in the Holy Communion of His body and blood. (1 Kings 3:15),

a. The blessing of security in a certain place and structure

- 1. He returned to Nazareth with them
- 2. He was obedient / subject to Joseph and Mary
- b. The blessing of storing treasures in the heart
 - 1. Treasure the Good News of what God has done for us
 - 2. Where neither moth nor rust decay, nor thieves break in
- c. The blessing of growing in wisdom, stature and favor with God
 - 1. Having wisdom in the things of God (small catechism)
 - 2. Growing in stature and favor with all the people
